~IMPORTANT INFORMATION~

The ACT test is given at Weber State University, Weber High School and Bonneville High School. Cost for the test is \$39.50, for the ACT test plus writing the cost is \$56.50. Fee waiver is available – see your counselor. If, during your senior year, you need your scores for scholarship applications, plan to take the October test to receive your results in time.

ACT test dates for the 2015 – 2016 school year:

** All juniors will take the ACT exam at Ben Lomond High School in March for FREE.

*If you miss the deadline, you can register during the late period for an additional late fee of \$24.

You can register for the ACT or find more information online at <u>www.actstudent.org</u>.

The SAT test costs \$54.50. Registration for basic subject tests is \$26 and each additional subject test is \$18. Fee waiver is available – see your counselor. If you register by phone there is an additional \$15 fee. If you need to make a change, as in test type, location or date of test it will be a \$28.00 fee.
