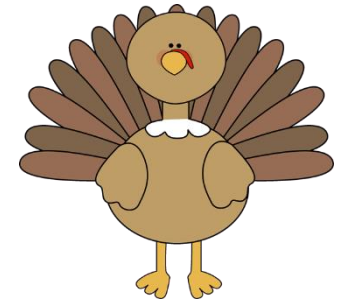

| 11/20/2015 | William Randolph Hearst Endowed Fellowship | Candidates for this fellowship are highly motivated graduate or undergraduate students from underrepresented communities of color. Candidates must be enrolled at an institution of higher education for the semester which they will be applying. Summer candidates must show proof of enrollment for the upcoming fall semester. Each candidate should have an excellent academic record and also have the following: 1. Demonstrated interest or experience in nonprofit organizations, philanthropy, and the social sector; 2. Excellent research and writing skills; 3. Demonstrated financial need; and 4. U.S. citizenship or U.S. permanent residency. Students approved for participation in the federal Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program are eligible to apply. This is not a scholarship. The student must be able to work as an intern for 12-15 weeks in the Washington, DC office of the Aspen Institute during the academic semester in which the fellowship is awarded. Fall and Spring interns will work part-time (15-20 hours per week) and Summer interns will be full-time. All travel and housing costs must be covered by the student. ~IMPORTANT INFORMATION~

The **ACT test** is given at Weber State University, Weber High School and Bonneville High School. Cost for the test is \$39.50, for the ACT test plus writing the cost is \$56.50. Fee waiver is available – see your counselor. If, during your senior year, you need your scores for scholarship applications, plan to take the October test to receive your results in time.

ACT test dates for the 2015 – 2016 school year:

**** All juniors will take the ACT exam at Ben Lomond High School in March for FREE.**

The **SAT test** costs \$54.50. Registration for basic subject tests is \$26 and each additional subject test is \$18. Fee waiver is available – see your counselor. If you register by phone there is an additional \$15 fee. If you need to make a change, as in test type, location or date of test it will be a \$28.00 fee.
